

WWJD is an acronym that was popularized in the 1990's. It stands for: What Would Jesus Do. The use of the acronym, most often on bracelets, was meant to be a reminder to Christians to consider the life of Jesus - His attitudes, words, and actions; as an example to follow, as we respond to the challenges that we face every day.

Writing this article on the eve of Easter week has caused me to think of another acronym: WDJD – What Did Jesus Do.

What did Jesus Do when He suffered, and died, and rose again?

A good answer to that question is found in an old hymn that has been popularized recently by the Christian band, Casting Crowns, with the title: Glorious Day.

The song includes these phrases in the chorus: Living, He loved me; Dying, He saved me; Buried, He carried my sins far away; Rising, He justified (each one of us) freely.

Out of appreciation for what Jesus HAS DONE for us: He loved us; He saved us; He carried our sins away from us; He makes it possible for us to one day appear before God "just as if we'd never sinned," and therefore, welcomed into heaven, our lives should be lived according to what the Apostle Paul wrote in Colossians 1:10.

Colossians 1:10 states: Walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to Him; bearing fruit in every good work.

Here's another phrase to use with the letters WWJD: Walk WITH Jesus Daily.

Celebrating Easter should cause us to say, "I want to walk WITH Jesus daily."






